The Prayer Life of Jesus

Scripture records 22 occasions where Jesus prayed. On 8 of those occasions, the Bible even gives us a record of <u>what</u> he prayed. All 22 occasions are listed below, with references, arranged chronologically to the best that can be determined.

<u>#1 - Lk. 3:21-22</u> The very beginning of Jesus' ministry was marked by prayer, accompanied by the opening of the heavens and the descent of the Holy Spirit!

<u>#2 - Mk. 1:35</u> After some intense ministry, Jesus still got up very early to commune with the Father.

<u>#3 - Lk. 5:16</u> Jesus placed a great priority on prayer.

<u>#4 - Lk. 6:12-13</u> Jesus set the example that before making important decisions, much prayer is necessary and appropriate.

<u>#5 - Mt. 11:25-26 / Lk 10:21</u> Jesus joyfully gave praise to his Father for the manner in which He bestowed revelation.

<u>#6 - Mt. 14:19 / Mk. 6:41 / Lk. 9:16 / Jn. 6:11</u> Jesus gave thanks to the Father for the little that was provided before multiplying it to feed a very large crowd.

<u>#7 - Mt. 14:22-23a</u> / <u>Mk. 6:45-46</u> Jesus showed by example that it is important, after a great miracle has been performed, to draw close to the Father.

<u>#8 - Lk. 9:18</u> On this occasion, Jesus had his disciples with him when he was in prayer to the Father.

<u>#9 - Mt. 15:36 / Mk. 8:6-7</u> Once again, Jesus is grateful to God for little before making it much.

<u>**#10 - Lk. 9:28-29**</u> Jesus' prayer here led to his being glorified, and then being visited by Moses and Elijah!

<u>#11</u> - **Lk. 11:1** There was something so attractive about Jesus' prayer life that his followers wanted to be taught to pray!

<u>#12</u> Jn. 11:41-44 Jesus paused to thank the Father publicly before raising Lazarus from the dead.

<u>#13</u> - Mt. 19:13-15 The reputation of Jesus' prayer life had spread quite far.

<u>#14</u> - Jn. 12:27-29 Here Jesus' 4-word prayer reveals the main passion of his life.

<u>#15 - Mt. 26:26-28 / Mk. 14:22-24 / Lk. 22:17-19</u> Jesus habitually thanked the Father for the food that He provided.

<u>**#16**</u> - <u>Lk. 22:31-32</u> Here Jesus' prayer was very personal – he prayed for Simon by name. It was also very specific – that Simon's faith would not fail.

<u>#17</u> - Jn. 17:1 - 18:1 This was the great "High-Priestly" prayer of Jesus for his followers. Just before his most horrible trial, he cared deeply that all his followers would be one.

#18 - Mt. 26:36-46 / Mk. 14:32-42 / Lk. 22:39-46 In the garden of Gethsemane Jesus prayed so earnestly that his sweat was like drops of blood. And his main concern was that his Father's will would be accomplished.

<u>#19 - Lk. 23:33-34</u> Here we see the complete purity of the Son of God, as he asked the Father to forgive his killers.

<u>**#20** - Mt. 27:46 / Mk. 15:34</u> Besides quoting Psalm 22, Jesus here asked the Father about their separation – which had never happened before!

<u>#21 - Lk. 23:46</u> Jesus' final prayer before dying – one of absolute trust.

<u>#22</u> - Lk. 24:30-31 Cleopas and another of Jesus' disciples recognized their Lord just after he prayed!
