- Gen. 31:27** Why did you run off secretly and deceive me? Why didn't you tell me, so I could send you away with **joy** and singing to the music of tambourines and harps?
- Lev. 9:24** Fire came out from the presence of the LORD and consumed the burnt offering and the fat portions on the altar. And when all the people saw it, they shouted for **joy** and fell facedown.
- Lev. 23:40** On the first day you are to take choice fruit from the trees, and palm fronds, leafy branches and poplars, and **rejoice** before the LORD your God for seven days.
- Num. 10:10** Also at your times of **rejoicing** – your appointed feasts and New Moon festivals – you are to sound the trumpets over your burnt offerings and fellowship offerings, and they will be a memorial for you before your God. I am the LORD your God.”
- Dt. 12:7** There, in the presence of the LORD your God, you and your families shall eat and shall **rejoice** in everything you have put your hand to, because the LORD your God has blessed you.
- Dt. 12:12** And there **rejoice** before the LORD your God, you, your sons and daughters, your menservants and maidservants, and the Levites from your towns, who have no allotment or inheritance of their own.
- Dt. 12:18** Instead, you are to eat them in the presence of the LORD your God at the place the LORD your God will choose – you, your sons and daughters, your menservants and maidservants, and the Levites from your towns – and you are to **rejoice** before the LORD your God in everything you put your hand to.
- Dt. 14:26** Use the silver to buy whatever you like: cattle, sheep, wine or other fermented drink, or anything you wish. Then you and your household shall eat there in the presence of the LORD your God and **rejoice**.
- Dt. 16:11** And **rejoice** before the LORD your God at the place he will choose as a dwelling for his Name – you, your sons and daughters, your menservants and maidservants, the Levites in your towns, and the aliens, the fatherless and the widows living among you.
- Dt. 16:14-15** Be **joyful** at your Feast – you, your sons and daughters, your menservants and maidservants, and the Levites, the aliens, the fatherless and the widows who live in your towns. For seven days celebrate the Feast to the LORD your God at the place the LORD will choose. For the LORD your God will bless you in all your harvest and in all the work of your hands, and your **joy** will be complete.
- Dt. 26:11** And you and the Levites and the aliens among you shall **rejoice** in all the good things the LORD your God has given to you and your household.
- Dt. 27:7** Sacrifice fellowship offerings there, eating them and **rejoicing** in the presence of the LORD your God.
- Dt. 28:47** Because you did not serve the LORD your God **joyfully** and gladly in the time of prosperity,

- Dt. 32:43** **Rejoice**, O nations, with his people,
for he will avenge the blood of his servants;
he will take vengeance on his enemies
and make atonement for his land and people.
- Dt. 33:18** About Zebulun he said: “**Rejoice**, Zebulun, in your going out, and you, Issachar, in your tents.
- Jdg. 9:19** if then you have acted honorably and in good faith toward Jerub-Baal and his family today, may Abimelech be your **joy**, and may you be his, too!
- 1Sam. 2:1** Then Hannah prayed and said:
“My heart **rejoices** in the LORD;
in the LORD my horn is lifted high.
My mouth boasts over my enemies,
for I delight in your deliverance.
- 1Sam. 6:13** Now the people of Beth Shemesh were harvesting their wheat in the valley, and when they looked up and saw the ark, they **rejoiced** at the sight.
- 1Sam. 18:6** When the men were returning home after David had killed the Philistine, the women came out from all the towns of Israel to meet King Saul with singing and dancing, with **joyful** songs and with tambourines and lutes.
- 2Sam. 1:20** “Tell it not in Gath,
proclaim it not in the streets of Ashkelon,
lest the daughters of the Philistines be glad,
lest the daughters of the uncircumcised **rejoice**.
- 2Sam. 6:12** Now King David was told, “The LORD has blessed the household of Obed-Edom and everything he has, because of the ark of God.” So David went down and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obed-Edom to the City of David with **rejoicing**.
- 1Ki. 1:40** And all the people went up after him, playing flutes and **rejoicing** greatly, so that the ground shook with the sound.
- 1Ki. 8:66** On the following day he sent the people away. They blessed the king and then went home, **joyful** and glad in heart for all the good things the LORD had done for his servant David and his people Israel.
- 2Ki. 11:14** She looked and there was the king, standing by the pillar, as the custom was. The officers and the trumpeters were beside the king, and all the people of the land were **rejoicing** and blowing trumpets. Then Athaliah tore her robes and called out, “Treason! Treason!”
- 2Ki. 11:20** and all the people of the land **rejoiced**. And the city was quiet, because Athaliah had been slain with the sword at the palace.
- 1Chr. 12:40** Also, their neighbors from as far away as Issachar, Zebulun and Naphtali came bringing food on donkeys, camels, mules and oxen. There were plentiful supplies of flour, fig cakes, raisin cakes, wine, oil, cattle and sheep, for there was **joy** in Israel.

- 1Chr. 15:16** David told the leaders of the Levites to appoint their brothers as singers to sing **joyful** songs, accompanied by musical instruments: lyres, harps and cymbals.
- 1Chr. 15:25** So David and the elders of Israel and the commanders of units of a thousand went to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD from the house of Obed-Edom, with **rejoicing**.
- 1Chr. 16:10** Glory in his holy name;
let the hearts of those who seek the LORD **rejoice**.
- 1Chr. 16:27** Splendor and majesty are before him;
strength and **joy** in his dwelling place.
- 1Chr. 16:31** Let the heavens **rejoice**, let the earth be glad;
let them say among the nations, "The LORD reigns!"
- 1Chr. 16:33** Then the trees of the forest will sing,
they will sing for **joy** before the LORD,
for he comes to judge the earth.
- 1Chr. 29:9** The people **rejoiced** at the willing response of their leaders, for they had given freely and wholeheartedly to the LORD. David the king also **rejoiced** greatly.
- 1Chr. 29:17** I know, my God, that you test the heart and are pleased with integrity. All these things have I given willingly and with honest intent. And now I have seen with **joy** how willingly your people who are here have given to you.
- 1Chr. 29:22** They ate and drank with great **joy** in the presence of the LORD that day. Then they acknowledged Solomon son of David as king a second time, anointing him before the LORD to be ruler and Zadok to be priest.
- 2Chr. 6:41** "Now arise, O LORD God, and come to your resting place,
you and the ark of your might.
May your priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation,
may your saints **rejoice** in your goodness.
- 2Chr. 7:10** On the twenty-third day of the seventh month he sent the people to their homes, **joyful** and glad in heart for the good things the LORD had done for David and Solomon and for his people Israel.
- 2Chr. 15:15** All Judah **rejoiced** about the oath because they had sworn it wholeheartedly. They sought God eagerly, and he was found by them. So the LORD gave them rest on every side.
- 2Chr. 20:27** Then, led by Jehoshaphat, all the men of Judah and Jerusalem returned **joyfully** to Jerusalem, for the LORD had given them cause to **rejoice** over their enemies.
- 2Chr. 23:13** She looked, and there was the king, standing by his pillar at the entrance. The officers and the trumpeters were beside the king, and all the people of the land were **rejoicing** and blowing trumpets, and singers with musical instruments were leading the praises. Then Athaliah tore her robes and shouted, "Treason! Treason!"
- 2Chr. 23:18** Then Jehoiada placed the oversight of the temple of the LORD in the hands of the priests, who were Levites, to whom David had made assignments in the temple, to present the burnt

offerings of the LORD as written in the Law of Moses, with **rejoicing** and singing, as David had ordered.

2Chr. 23:21 and all the people of the land **rejoiced**. And the city was quiet, because Athaliah had been slain with the sword.

2Chr. 29:36 Hezekiah and all the people **rejoiced** at what God had brought about for his people, because it was done so quickly.

2Chr. 30:21 The Israelites who were present in Jerusalem celebrated the Feast of Unleavened Bread for seven days with great **rejoicing**, while the Levites and priests sang to the LORD every day, accompanied by the LORD's instruments of praise.

2Chr. 30:23 The whole assembly then agreed to celebrate the festival seven more days; so for another seven days they celebrated **joyfully**.

2Chr. 30:25-26 The entire assembly of Judah **rejoiced**, along with the priests and Levites and all who had assembled from Israel, including the aliens who had come from Israel and those who lived in Judah. There was great **joy** in Jerusalem, for since the days of Solomon son of David king of Israel there had been nothing like this in Jerusalem.

Ezr. 3:12-13 But many of the older priests and Levites and family heads, who had seen the former temple, wept aloud when they saw the foundation of this temple being laid, while many others shouted for **joy**. No one could distinguish the sound of the shouts of **joy** from the sound of weeping, because the people made so much noise. And the sound was heard far away.

Ezr. 6:16 Then the people of Israel – the priests, the Levites and the rest of the exiles – celebrated the dedication of the house of God with **joy**.

Ezr. 6:22 For seven days they celebrated with **joy** the Feast of Unleavened Bread, because the LORD had filled them with **joy** by changing the attitude of the king of Assyria, so that he assisted them in the work on the house of God, the God of Israel.

Neh. 8:10 Nehemiah said, "Go and enjoy choice food and sweet drinks, and send some to those who have nothing prepared. This day is sacred to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the **joy** of the LORD is your strength."

Neh. 8:12 Then all the people went away to eat and drink, to send portions of food and to celebrate with great **joy**, because they now understood the words that had been made known to them.

Neh. 8:17 The whole company that had returned from exile built booths and lived in them. From the days of Joshua son of Nun until that day, the Israelites had not celebrated it like this. And their **joy** was very great.

Neh. 12:27 At the dedication of the wall of Jerusalem, the Levites were sought out from where they lived and were brought to Jerusalem to celebrate **joyfully** the dedication with songs of thanksgiving and with the music of cymbals, harps and lyres.

Neh. 12:43 And on that day they offered great sacrifices, **rejoicing** because God had given them great **joy**. The women and children also **rejoiced**. The sound of **rejoicing** in Jerusalem could be heard far away.

Est. 8:15-17 Mordecai left the king's presence wearing royal garments of blue and white, a large crown of gold and a purple robe of fine linen. And the city of Susa held a **joyous** celebration. For the Jews it was a time of happiness and **joy**, gladness and honor. In every province and in every city, wherever the edict of the king went, there was **joy** and gladness among the Jews, with feasting and celebrating. And many people of other nationalities became Jews because fear of the Jews had seized them.

Est. 9:17 This happened on the thirteenth day of the month of Adar, and on the fourteenth they rested and made it a day of feasting and **joy**.

Est. 9:18 The Jews in Susa, however, had assembled on the thirteenth and fourteenth, and then on the fifteenth they rested and made it a day of feasting and **joy**.

Est. 9:19 That is why rural Jews – those living in villages – observe the fourteenth of the month of Adar as a day of **joy** and feasting, a day for giving presents to each other.

Est. 9:22 as the time when the Jews got relief from their enemies, and as the month when their sorrow was turned into **joy** and their mourning into a day of celebration. He wrote them to observe the days as days of feasting and **joy** and giving presents of food to one another and gifts to the poor.

Job 3:7 May that night be barren;
may no shout of **joy** be heard in it.

Job 3:22 who are filled with gladness
and **rejoice** when they reach the grave?

Job 6:10 Then I would still have this consolation –
my **joy** in unrelenting pain –
that I had not denied the words of the Holy One.

Job 8:21 He will yet fill your mouth with laughter
and your lips with shouts of **joy**.

Job 9:25 “My days are swifter than a runner;
they fly away without a glimpse of **joy**.”

Job 10:20 Are not my few days almost over?
Turn away from me so I can have a moment's **joy**

Job 20:5 that the mirth of the wicked is brief,
the **joy** of the godless lasts but a moment.

Job 22:19 “The righteous see their ruin and **rejoice**;
the innocent mock them, saying,

Job 31:25 if I have **rejoiced** over my great wealth,
the fortune my hands had gained,

Job 31:29 “If I have **rejoiced** at my enemy's misfortune
or gloated over the trouble that came to him –

- Job 33:26** He prays to God and finds favor with him,
he sees God's face and shouts for **joy**;
he is restored by God to his righteous state.
- Job 38:7** while the morning stars sang together
and all the angels shouted for **joy**?
- Job 39:13** "The wings of the ostrich flap **joyfully**,
but they cannot compare with the pinions and feathers of the stork.
- Job 39:21** He paws fiercely, **rejoicing** in his strength,
and charges into the fray.
- Ps. 2:11** Serve the LORD with fear
and **rejoice** with trembling.
- Ps. 4:7** You have filled my heart with greater **joy**
than when their grain and new wine abound.
- Ps. 5:11** But let all who take refuge in you be glad;
let them ever sing for **joy**.
Spread your protection over them,
that those who love your name may **rejoice** in you.
- Ps. 9:2** I will be glad and **rejoice** in you;
I will sing praise to your name, O Most High.
- Ps. 9:14** that I may declare your praises
in the gates of the Daughter of Zion
and there **rejoice** in your salvation.
- Ps. 13:4** my enemy will say, "I have overcome him,"
and my foes will **rejoice** when I fall.
- Ps. 13:5** But I trust in your unfailing love;
my heart **rejoices** in your salvation.
- Ps. 14:7** Oh, that salvation for Israel would come out of Zion!
When the LORD restores the fortunes of his people,
let Jacob **rejoice** and Israel be glad!

- Ps. 19:8** The precepts of the LORD are right,
giving **joy** to the heart.
The commands of the LORD are radiant,
giving light to the eyes.
- Ps. 20:5** We will shout for **joy** when you are victorious
and will lift up our banners in the name of our God.
May the LORD grant all your requests.
- Ps. 21:1** O LORD, the king **rejoices** in your strength.
How great is his **joy** in the victories you give!
- Ps. 21:6** Surely you have granted him eternal blessings
and made him glad with the **joy** of your presence.
- Ps. 27:6** Then my head will be exalted
above the enemies who surround me;
at his tabernacle will I sacrifice with shouts of **joy**;
I will sing and make music to the LORD.
- Ps. 28:7** The LORD is my strength and my shield;
my heart trusts in him, and I am helped.
My heart leaps for **joy**
and I will give thanks to him in song.
- Ps. 30:5** For his anger lasts only a moment,
but his favor lasts a lifetime;
weeping may remain for a night,
but **rejoicing** comes in the morning.
- Ps. 30:11** You turned my wailing into dancing;
you removed my sackcloth and clothed me with **joy**,
- Ps. 31:7** I will be glad and **rejoice** in your love,
for you saw my affliction
and knew the anguish of my soul.
- Ps. 32:11** **Rejoice** in the LORD and be glad, you righteous;
sing, all you who are upright in heart!
- Ps. 33:1** Sing **joyfully** to the LORD, you righteous;
it is fitting for the upright to praise him.
- Ps. 33:3** Sing to him a new song;
play skillfully, and shout for **joy**.
- Ps. 33:21** In him our hearts **rejoice**,
for we trust in his holy name.
- Ps. 34:2** My soul will boast in the LORD;
let the afflicted hear and **rejoice**.

- Ps. 35:9** Then my soul will **rejoice** in the LORD
and delight in his salvation.
- Ps. 35:27** May those who delight in my vindication
shout for **joy** and gladness;
may they always say, "The LORD be exalted,
who delights in the well-being of his servant."
- Ps. 39:13** Look away from me, that I may **rejoice** again
before I depart and am no more."
- Ps. 40:16** But may all who seek you
rejoice and be glad in you;
may those who love your salvation always say,
"The LORD be exalted!"
- Ps. 42:4** These things I remember
as I pour out my soul:
how I used to go with the multitude,
leading the procession to the house of God,
with shouts of **joy** and thanksgiving
among the festive throng.
- Ps. 43:4** Then will I go to the altar of God,
to God, my **joy** and my delight.
I will praise you with the harp,
O God, my God.
- Ps. 45:7** You love righteousness and hate wickedness;
therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions
by anointing you with the oil of **joy**.
- Ps. 45:15** They are led in with **joy** and gladness;

shout to God with cries of **joy**.
- Ps. 47:5** God has ascended amid shouts of **joy**,

Like the utmost heights of Zaphon is Mount Zion,

- Ps. 98:4 Shout for **joy** to the LORD, all the earth,

- Pr. 23:24** The father of a righteous man has great **joy**;
he who has a wise son delights in him.
- Pr. 23:25** May your father and mother be glad;
may she who gave you birth **rejoice!**
- Pr. 24:17** Do not gloat when your enemy falls;
when he stumbles, do not let your heart **rejoice**,
- Pr. 27:9** Perfume and incense bring **joy** to the heart,
and the pleasantness of one's friend springs from his earnest counsel.

- Pr. 27:11** Be wise, my son, and bring **joy** to my heart;
then I can answer anyone who treats me with contempt.
- Pr. 29:2** When the righteous thrive, the people **rejoice**;
when the wicked rule, the people groan.
- Pr. 29:3** A man who loves wisdom brings **joy** to his father,
but a companion of prostitutes squanders his wealth.
- Ecc. 8:15** So I commend the enjoyment of life, because nothing is better for a man under the sun
than to eat and drink and be glad. Then **joy** will accompany him in his work all the days of the life
God has given him under the sun.
- Ecc. 9:7** Go, eat your food with gladness, and drink your wine with a **joyful** heart, for it is now that
God favors what you do.
- Ecc. 11:9** Be happy, young man, while you are young,
and let your heart give you **joy** in the days of your youth.
Follow the ways of your heart
and whatever your eyes see,
but know that for all these things
God will bring you to judgment.
- SoS 1:4** Take me away with you – let us hurry!
Let the king bring me into his chambers.
We **rejoice** and delight in you;
we will praise your love more than wine.
How right they are to adore you!
- SoS 3:11** Come out, you daughters of Zion,
and look at King Solomon wearing the crown,
the crown with which his mother crowned him
on the day of his wedding,
the day his heart **rejoiced**.
- Is. 8:6** “Because this people has rejected
the gently flowing waters of Shiloah
and **rejoices** over Rezin
and the son of Remaliah,
- Is. 9:3** You have enlarged the nation
and increased their **joy**;
they **rejoice** before you
as people **rejoice** at the harvest,
as men **rejoice**
when dividing the plunder.
- Is. 12:3** With **joy** you will draw water
from the wells of salvation.
- Is. 12:6** Shout aloud and sing for **joy**, people of Zion,
for great is the Holy One of Israel among you.”

- Is. 13:3 I have commanded my holy ones;
I have summoned my warriors to carry out my wrath –
those who **rejoice** in my triumph.
- Is. 14:29 Do not **rejoice**, all you Philistines,
that the rod that struck you is broken;
from the root of that snake will spring up a viper,
its fruit will be a darting, venomous serpent.
- Is. 16:9 So I weep, as Jazer weeps,
for the vines of Sibmah.
O Heshbon, O Elealeh,
I drench you with tears!
The shouts of **joy** over your ripened fruit
and over your harvests have been stilled.
- Is. 16:10 **Joy** and gladness are taken away from the orchards;
no one sings or shouts in the vineyards;
no one treads out wine at the presses,
for I have put an end to the shouting.
- Is. 22:13 But see, there is **joy** and revelry,
slaughtering of cattle and killing of sheep,
eating of meat and drinking of wine!
“Let us eat and drink,” you say,
“for tomorrow we die!”
- Is. 24:8 The gaiety of the tambourines is stilled,
the noise of the revelers has stopped,
the **joyful** harp is silent.
- Is. 24:11 In the streets they cry out for wine;
all **joy** turns to gloom,
all gaiety is banished from the earth.
- Is. 24:14 They raise their voices, they shout for **joy**;
from the west they acclaim the LORD’s majesty.
- Is. 25:9 In that day they will say,
“Surely this is our God;
we trusted in him, and he saved us.
This is the LORD, we trusted in him;
let us **rejoice** and be glad in his salvation.”
- Is. 26:19 But your dead will live;
their bodies will rise.
You who dwell in the dust,
wake up and shout for **joy**.
Your dew is like the dew of the morning;
the earth will give birth to her dead.

- Is. 29:19** Once more the humble will **rejoice** in the LORD;
the needy will **rejoice** in the Holy One of Israel.
- Is. 30:29** And you will sing
as on the night you celebrate a holy festival;
your hearts will **rejoice**
as when people go up with flutes
to the mountain of the LORD,
to the Rock of Israel.
- Is. 35:1-2** The desert and the parched land will be glad;
the wilderness will **rejoice** and blossom.
Like the crocus, it will burst into bloom;
it will **rejoice** greatly and shout for **joy**.
The glory of Lebanon will be given to it,
the splendor of Carmel and Sharon;
they will see the glory of the LORD,
the splendor of our God.
- Is. 35:6** Then will the lame leap like a deer,
and the mute tongue shout for **joy**.
Water will gush forth in the wilderness
and streams in the desert.
- Is. 35:10** and the ransomed of the LORD will return.
They will enter Zion with singing;
everlasting **joy** will crown their heads.
Gladness and **joy** will overtake them,
and sorrow and sighing will flee away.
- Is. 41:16** You will winnow them, the wind will pick them up,
and a gale will blow them away.
But you will **rejoice** in the LORD
and glory in the Holy One of Israel.
- Is. 42:11** Let the desert and its towns raise their voices;
let the settlements where Kedar lives **rejoice**.
Let the people of Sela sing for **joy**;
let them shout from the mountaintops.
- Is. 44:23** Sing for **joy**, O heavens, for the LORD has done this;
shout aloud, O earth beneath.
Burst into song, you mountains,
you forests and all your trees,
for the LORD has redeemed Jacob,
he displays his glory in Israel.
- Is. 48:20** Leave Babylon,
flee from the Babylonians!
Announce this with shouts of **joy**
and proclaim it.
Send it out to the ends of the earth;

say, "The LORD has redeemed his servant Jacob."

- Is. 49:13** Shout for **joy**, O heavens;
rejoice, O earth;
burst into song, O mountains!
For the LORD comforts his people
and will have compassion on his afflicted ones.
- Is. 51:3** The LORD will surely comfort Zion
and will look with compassion on all her ruins;
he will make her deserts like Eden,
her wastelands like the garden of the LORD.
Joy and gladness will be found in her,
thanksgiving and the sound of singing.
- Is. 51:11** The ransomed of the LORD will return.
They will enter Zion with singing;
everlasting **joy** will crown their heads.
Gladness and **joy** will overtake them,
and sorrow and sighing will flee away.
- Is. 52:8** Listen! Your watchmen lift up their voices;
together they shout for **joy**.
When the LORD returns to Zion,
they will see it with their own eyes.
- Is. 52:9** Burst into songs of **joy** together,

you who pillage my inheritance,
because you frolic like a heifer threshing grain
and neigh like stallions,
- Jer. 51:48** Then heaven and earth and all that is in them
will shout for **joy** over Babylon,
for out of the north
destroyers will attack her,” declares the LORD.

- Lam. 1:21** “People have heard my groaning,
but there is no one to comfort me.
All my enemies have heard of my distress;
they **rejoice** at what you have done.
May you bring the day you have announced
so they may become like me.
- Lam. 2:15** All who pass your way
clap their hands at you;
they scoff and shake their heads
at the Daughter of Jerusalem:
“Is this the city that was called
the perfection of beauty,
the **joy** of the whole earth?”

near; there is panic, not **joy**, upon the mountains.
- Ez. 7:12** The time has come, the day has arrived. Let not the buyer **rejoice** nor the seller grieve, for
wrath is upon the whole crowd.
- Ez. 21:10** sharpened for the slaughter,
polished to flash like lightning!
“ ‘Shall we **rejoice** in the scepter of my son [Judah]? The sword despises every such stick.

you love the wages of a prostitute
at every threshing floor.

- Hos. 10:5** The people who live in Samaria fear
for the calf-idol of Beth Aven.
Its people will mourn over it,
and so will its idolatrous priests,
those who had **rejoiced** over its splendor,
because it is taken from them into exile.
- Jol. 1:12** The vine is dried up
and the fig tree is withered;
the pomegranate, the palm and the apple tree –
all the trees of the field – are dried up.
Surely the **joy** of mankind
is withered away.
- Jol. 1:16** Has not the food been cut off
before our very eyes –
joy and gladness
from the house of our God?
- Jol. 2:21** Be not afraid, O land; be glad and **rejoice**. Surely the LORD has done great things.
- Jol. 2:23** Be glad, O people of Zion,
rejoice in the LORD your God,
for he has given you
the autumn rains in righteousness.
He sends you abundant showers,

he catches them in his net,
he gathers them up in his dragnet;
and so he **rejoices** and is glad.
- Hab. 3:18** yet I will **rejoice** in the LORD,
I will be **joyful** in God my Savior.
- Zph. 3:11** On that day you will not be put to shame
for all the wrongs you have done to me,
because I will remove from this city
those who **rejoice** in their pride.
Never again will you be haughty
on my holy hill.

- Zph. 3:14** Sing, O Daughter of Zion;
shout aloud, O Israel!
Be glad and **rejoice** with all your heart,
O Daughter of Jerusalem!

- Mt. 5:12** **Rejoice** and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.
- Mt. 13:20** The one who received the seed that fell on rocky places is the man who hears the word and at once receives it with **joy**.
- Mt. 13:44** “The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his **joy** went and sold all he had and bought that field.
- Mt. 28:8** So the women hurried away from the tomb, afraid yet filled with **joy**, and ran to tell his disciples.
- Mk. 4:16** Others, like seed sown on rocky places, hear the word and at once receive it with **joy**.
- Lk. 1:14** He will be a **joy** and delight to you, and many will **rejoice** because of his birth,
- Lk. 1:44** As soon as the sound of your greeting reached my ears, the baby in my womb leaped for **joy**.

Lk. 1:47 and my spirit **rejoices** in God my Savior,

Lk. 1:58 Her neighbors and relatives heard that the Lord had shown her great mercy, and they shared her **joy**.

Lk. 2:10 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great **joy** that will be for all the people.

Lk. 6:23 "**Rejoice** in that day and leap for **joy**, because great is your reward in heaven. For that is how their fathers treated the prophets.

Lk. 8:13 Those on the rock are the ones who receive the word with **joy** when they hear it, but they have no root. They believe for a while, but in the time of testing they fall away.

Lk. 10:17 The seventy-two returned with **joy** and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name."

Lk. 10:20 However, do not **rejoice** that the spirits submit to you, but **rejoice** that your names are written in heaven."

Lk. 10:21 At that time Jesus, full of **joy** through the Holy Spirit, said, "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children. Yes, Father, for this was your good pleasure.

Lk. 15:5-7 And when he finds it, he **joyfully** puts it on his shoulders and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' I tell you that in the same way there will be more **rejoicing** in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

Lk. 15:9-10 And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.' In the same way, I tell you, there is **rejoicing** in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

Lk. 19:37 When he came near the place where the road goes down the Mount of Olives, the whole crowd of disciples began **joyfully** to praise God in loud voices for all the miracles they had seen:

Lk. 24:41 And while they still did not believe it because of **joy** and amazement, he asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?"

Lk. 24:52 Then they worshiped him and returned to Jerusalem with great **joy**.

Jn. 3:29 The bride belongs to the bridegroom. The friend who attends the bridegroom waits and listens for him, and is full of **joy** when he hears the bridegroom's voice. That **joy** is mine, and it is now complete.

Jn. 8:56 Your father Abraham **rejoiced** at the thought of seeing my day; he saw it and was glad."

Jn. 15:11 I have told you this so that my **joy** may be in you and that your **joy** may be complete.

Jn. 16:20-22 I tell you the truth, you will weep and mourn while the world **rejoices**. You will grieve, but your grief will turn to **joy**. A woman giving birth to a child has pain because her time has come; but when her baby is born she forgets the anguish because of her **joy** that a child is born into the

world. So with you: Now is your time of grief, but I will see you again and you will **rejoice**, and no one will take away your **joy**.

Jn. 16:24 Until now you have not asked for anything in my name. Ask and you will receive, and your **joy** will be complete.

Jn. 17:13 “I am coming to you now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of my **joy** within them.

Jn. 20:20 After he said this, he showed them his hands and side. The disciples were **overjoyed** when they saw the Lord.

Ac. 2:26 Therefore my heart is glad and my tongue **rejoices**;
my body also will live in hope,

Ac. 2:28 You have made known to me the paths of life;
you will fill me with **joy** in your presence.’

Ac. 5:41 The apostles left the Sanhedrin, **rejoicing** because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name.

Ac. 8:8 So there was great **joy** in that city.

Ac. 8:39 When they came up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord suddenly took Philip away, and the eunuch did not see him again, but went on his way **rejoicing**.

Ac. 12:14 When she recognized Peter’s voice, she was so **overjoyed** she ran back without opening it and exclaimed, “Peter is at the door!”

Ac. 13:52 And the disciples were filled with **joy** and with the Holy Spirit.

Ac. 14:17 Yet he has not left himself without testimony: He has shown kindness by giving you rain from heaven and crops in their seasons; he provides you with plenty of food and fills your hearts with **joy**.”

Ac. 16:34 The jailer brought them into his house and set a meal before them; he was filled with **joy** because he had come to believe in God – he and his whole family.

Ro. 5:2-3 through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we **rejoice** in the hope of the glory of God. Not only so, but we also **rejoice** in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces perseverance;

Ro. 5:11 Not only is this so, but we also **rejoice** in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received reconciliation.

Ro. 12:12 Be **joyful** in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.

Ro. 12:15 **Rejoice** with those who **rejoice**; mourn with those who mourn.

Ro. 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and **joy** in the Holy Spirit,

- Ro. 15:10** Again, it says, “**Rejoice**, O Gentiles, with his people.”
- Ro. 15:13** May the God of hope fill you with all **joy** and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Ro. 15:32** so that by God’s will I may come to you with **joy** and together with you be refreshed.
- Ro. 16:19** Everyone has heard about your obedience, so I am full of **joy** over you; but I want you to be wise about what is good, and innocent about what is evil.
- 1Co. 12:26** If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honored, every part **rejoices** with it.

- 2Co. 7:4** I have great confidence in you; I take great pride in you. I am greatly encouraged; in all our troubles my **joy** knows no bounds.
- 2Co. 7:7** and not only by his coming but also by the comfort you had given him. He told us about your longing for me, your deep sorrow, your ardent concern for me, so that my **joy** was greater than ever.
- 2Co. 8:2** Out of the most severe trial, their overflowing **joy** and their extreme poverty welled up in rich generosity.
- Gal. 4:15** What has happened to all your **joy**? I can testify that, if you could have done so, you would have torn out your eyes and given them to me.
- Gal. 5:22** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, **joy**, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
- Pp. 1:4** In all my prayers for all of you, I always pray with **joy**
- Pp. 1:18** But what does it matter? The important thing is that in every way, whether from false motives or true, Christ is preached. And because of this I **rejoice**. Yes, and I will continue to **rejoice**,
- Pp. 1:25-26** Convinced of this, I know that I will remain, and I will continue with all of you for your progress and **joy** in the faith, so that through my being with you again your **joy** in Christ Jesus will overflow on account of me.
- Pp. 2:2** then make my **joy** complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose.

- Pp. 2:17-18** But even if I am being poured out like a drink offering on the sacrifice and service coming from your faith, I am glad and **rejoice** with all of you. So you too should be glad and **rejoice** with me.
- Pp. 2:29** Welcome him in the Lord with great **joy**, and honor men like him,
- Pp. 3:1** Finally, my brothers, **rejoice** in the Lord! It is no trouble for me to write the same things to you again, and it is a safeguard for you.
- Pp. 4:1** Therefore, my brothers, you whom I love and long for, my **joy** and crown, that is how you should stand firm in the Lord, dear friends!
- Pp. 4:4** **Rejoice** in the Lord always. I will say it again: **Rejoice!**
- Pp. 4:10** I **rejoice** greatly in the Lord that at last you have renewed your concern for me. Indeed, you have been concerned, but you had no opportunity to show it.
- Col. 1:11** being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience, and **joyfully**
- Col. 1:24** Now I **rejoice** in what was suffered for you, and I fill up in my flesh what is still lacking in regard to Christ's afflictions, for the sake of his body, which is the church.
- 1Th. 1:6** You became imitators of us and of the Lord; in spite of severe suffering, you welcomed the message with the **joy** given by the Holy Spirit.
- 1Th. 2:19-20** For what is our hope, our **joy**, or the crown in which we will glory in the presence of our Lord Jesus when he comes? Is it not you? Indeed, you are our glory and **joy**.
- 1Th. 3:9** How can we thank God enough for you in return for all the **joy** we have in the presence of our God because of you?
- 1Th. 5:16** Be **joyful** always;
- 2Tim. 1:4** Recalling your tears, I long to see you, so that I may be filled with **joy**.
- Pm. 7** Your love has given me great **joy** and encouragement, because you, brother, have refreshed the hearts of the saints.
- Heb. 1:9** You have loved righteousness and hated wickedness; therefore God, your God, has set you above your companions by anointing you with the oil of **joy**."
- Heb. 10:34** You sympathized with those in prison and **joyfully** accepted the confiscation of your property, because you knew that you yourselves had better and lasting possessions.
- Heb. 12:2** Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the **joy** set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Heb. 12:22** But you have come to Mount Zion, to the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in **joyful** assembly,

- Heb. 13:17** Obey your leaders and submit to their authority. They keep watch over you as men who must give an account. Obey them so that their work will be a **joy**, not a burden, for that would be of no advantage to you.
- Jas. 1:2** Consider it pure **joy**, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds,
- Jas. 4:9** Grieve, mourn and wail. Change your laughter to mourning and your **joy** to gloom.
- 1Pt. 1:6** In this you greatly **rejoice**, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials.
- 1Pt. 1:8** Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious **joy**,
- 1Pt. 4:13** But **rejoice** that you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be **overjoyed** when his glory is revealed.
- 1Jn. 1:4** We write this to make our **joy** complete.
- 2Jn. 4** It has given me great **joy** to find some of your children walking in the truth, just as the Father commanded us.
- 2Jn. 12** I have much to write to you, but I do not want to use paper and ink. Instead, I hope to visit you and talk with you face to face, so that our **joy** may be complete.
- 3Jn. 3-4** It gave me great **joy** to have some brothers come and tell about your faithfulness to the truth and how you continue to walk in the truth. I have no greater **joy** than to hear that my children are walking in the truth.
- Ju. 24** To him who is able to keep you from falling and to present you before his glorious presence without fault and with great **joy** –
- Rev. 12:12** Therefore **rejoice**, you heavens
and you who dwell in them!
But woe to the earth and the sea,
because the devil has gone down to you!
He is filled with fury,
because he knows that his time is short.”
- Rev. 18:20** **Rejoice** over her, O heaven!
Rejoice, saints and apostles and prophets!
God has judged her for the way she treated you.”
- Rev. 19:7** Let us **rejoice** and be glad
and give him glory!
For the wedding of the Lamb has come,
and his bride has made herself ready.
