patient / patience / patiently / impatient (48)

- Num. 21:4 They traveled from Mount Hor along the route to the Red Sea, to go around Edom. But the people grew impatient on the way;
- Neh. 9:30 For many years you were **patient** with them. By your Spirit you admonished them through your prophets. Yet they paid no attention, so you handed them over to the neighboring peoples.
- Job 4:2 "If someone ventures a word with you, will you be **impatient**? But who can keep from speaking?
- Job 6:11 "What strength do I have, that I should still hope? What prospects, that I should be **patient**?
- Job 21:4 "Is my complaint directed to man?
 Why should I not be **impatient**?
- Ps. 37:7 Be still before the LORD and wait **patiently** for him; do not fret when men succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes.
- Ps. 40:1 I waited **patiently** for the LORD; he turned to me and heard my cry.
- Pr. 14:29 A **patient** man has great understanding, but a quick-tempered man displays folly.
- Pr. 15:18 A hot-tempered man stirs up dissension, but a **patient** man calms a quarrel.
- Pr. 16:32 Better a **patient** man than a warrior, a man who controls his temper than one who takes a city.
- Pr. 19:11 A man's wisdom gives him **patience**; it is to his glory to overlook an offense.
- Pr. 25:15 Through **patience** a ruler can be persuaded, and a gentle tongue can break a bone.
- Ecc. 7:8 The end of a matter is better than its beginning, and **patience** is better than pride.
- Is. 7:13 Then Isaiah said, "Hear now, you house of David! Is it not enough to try the **patience** of men? Will you try the **patience** of my God also?
- Is. 38:13 I waited **patiently** till dawn, but like a lion he broke all my bones; day and night you made an end of me.

- Ac. 26:3 and especially so because you are well acquainted with all the Jewish customs and controversies. Therefore, I beg you to listen to me **patiently**.

- Ro. 8:25 But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it **patiently**.

- 1Th. 5:14 And we urge you, brothers, warn those who are idle, encourage the timid, help the weak, be **patient** with everyone.

- 1Pt. 3:20 who disobeyed long ago when God waited **patiently** in the days of Noah while the ark was being built. In it only a few people, eight in all, were saved through water,
- **2Pt. 3:9** The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is **patient** with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.
- 2Pt. 3:15 Bear in mind that our Lord's **patience** means salvation, just as our dear brother Paul also wrote you with the wisdom that God gave him.
- Rev. 1:9 I, John, your brother and companion in the suffering and kingdom and **patient** endurance that are ours in Jesus, was on the island of Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.
- Rev. 3:10 Since you have kept my command to endure **patiently**, I will also keep you from the hour of trial that is going to come upon the whole world to test those who live on the earth.
- Rev. 13:10 If anyone is to go into captivity, into captivity he will go.

 If anyone is to be killed with the sword, with the sword he will be killed.

This calls for **patient** endurance and faithfulness on the part of the saints.

Rev. 14:12 This calls for **patient** endurance on the part of the saints who obey God's commandments and remain faithful to Jesus.
