

## patient / patience / patiently / impatient (48)

- Num. 21:4** They traveled from Mount Hor along the route to the Red Sea, to go around Edom. But the people grew **impatient** on the way;
- Neh. 9:30** For many years you were **patient** with them. By your Spirit you admonished them through your prophets. Yet they paid no attention, so you handed them over to the neighboring peoples.
- Job 4:2** “If someone ventures a word with you, will you be **impatient**?  
But who can keep from speaking?”
- Job 6:11** “What strength do I have, that I should still hope?  
What prospects, that I should be **patient**?”
- Job 21:4** “Is my complaint directed to man?  
Why should I not be **impatient**?”
- Ps. 37:7** Be still before the LORD and wait **patiently** for him;  
do not fret when men succeed in their ways,  
when they carry out their wicked schemes.
- Ps. 40:1** I waited **patiently** for the LORD;  
he turned to me and heard my cry.
- Pr. 14:29** A **patient** man has great understanding,  
but a quick-tempered man displays folly.
- Pr. 15:18** A hot-tempered man stirs up dissension,  
but a **patient** man calms a quarrel.
- Pr. 16:32** Better a **patient** man than a warrior,  
a man who controls his temper than one who takes a city.
- Pr. 19:11** A man’s wisdom gives him **patience**;  
it is to his glory to overlook an offense.
- Pr. 25:15** Through **patience** a ruler can be persuaded,  
and a gentle tongue can break a bone.
- Ecc. 7:8** The end of a matter is better than its beginning,  
and **patience** is better than pride.
- Is. 7:13** Then Isaiah said, “Hear now, you house of David! Is it not enough to try the **patience** of men? Will you try the **patience** of my God also?”
- Is. 38:13** I waited **patiently** till dawn,  
but like a lion he broke all my bones;  
day and night you made an end of me.

- Hab. 3:16** I heard and my heart pounded,  
my lips quivered at the sound;  
decay crept into my bones,  
and my legs trembled.  
Yet I will wait **patiently** for the day of calamity  
to come on the nation invading us.
- Mt. 18:26** “The servant fell on his knees before him. ‘Be **patient** with me,’ he begged, ‘and I will pay back everything.’
- Mt. 18:29** “His fellow servant fell to his knees and begged him, ‘Be **patient** with me, and I will pay you back.’
- Ac. 26:3** and especially so because you are well acquainted with all the Jewish customs and controversies. Therefore, I beg you to listen to me **patiently**.
- Ro. 2:4** Or do you show contempt for the riches of his kindness, tolerance and **patience**, not realizing that God’s kindness leads you toward repentance?
- Ro. 8:25** But if we hope for what we do not yet have, we wait for it **patiently**.
- Ro. 9:22** What if God, choosing to show his wrath and make his power known, bore with great **patience** the objects of his wrath – prepared for destruction?
- Ro. 12:12** Be joyful in hope, **patient** in affliction, faithful in prayer.
- 1Co. 13:4** Love is **patient**, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.
- 2Co. 1:6** If we are distressed, it is for your comfort and salvation; if we are comforted, it is for your comfort, which produces in you **patient** endurance of the same sufferings we suffer.
- 2Co. 6:6** in purity, understanding, **patience** and kindness; in the Holy Spirit and in sincere love;
- Gal. 5:22** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, **patience**, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,
- Eph. 4:2** Be completely humble and gentle; be **patient**, bearing with one another in love.
- Col. 1:11** being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and **patience**, and joyfully
- Col. 3:12** Therefore, as God’s chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and **patience**.
- 1Th. 5:14** And we urge you, brothers, warn those who are idle, encourage the timid, help the weak, be **patient** with everyone.
- 1Tim. 1:16** But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his unlimited **patience** as an example for those who would believe on him and receive eternal life.
- 2Tim. 3:10** You, however, know all about my teaching, my way of life, my purpose, faith, **patience**, love, endurance,

**2Tim. 4:2** Preach the Word; be prepared in season and out of season; correct, rebuke and encourage – with great **patience** and careful instruction.

**Heb. 6:12** We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those who through faith and **patience** inherit what has been promised.

**Heb. 6:15** And so after waiting **patiently**, Abraham received what was promised.

**Jas. 5:7-8** Be **patient**, then, brothers, until the Lord's coming. See how the farmer waits for the land to yield its valuable crop and how **patient** he is for the autumn and spring rains. You too, be **patient** and stand firm, because the Lord's coming is near.

**Jas. 5:10** Brothers, as an example of **patience** in the face of suffering, take the prophets who spoke in the name of the Lord.

**1Pt. 3:20** who disobeyed long ago when God waited **patiently** in the days of Noah while the ark was being built. In it only a few people, eight in all, were saved through water,

**2Pt. 3:9** The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is **patient** with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.

**2Pt. 3:15** Bear in mind that our Lord's **patience** means salvation, just as our dear brother Paul also wrote you with the wisdom that God gave him.

**Rev. 1:9** I, John, your brother and companion in the suffering and kingdom and **patient** endurance that are ours in Jesus, was on the island of Patmos because of the word of God and the testimony of Jesus.

**Rev. 3:10** **Since you have kept my command to endure patiently, I will also keep you from the hour of trial that is going to come upon the whole world to test those who live on the earth.**

**Rev. 13:10** If anyone is to go into captivity,  
into captivity he will go.  
If anyone is to be killed with the sword,  
with the sword he will be killed.  
This calls for **patient** endurance and faithfulness on the part of the saints.

**Rev. 14:12** This calls for **patient** endurance on the part of the saints who obey God's commandments and remain faithful to Jesus.
