Gen. 24:27 saying, "Praise be to the LORD, the God of my master Abraham, who has not abandoned his kindness and **faithfulness** to my master. As for me, the LORD has led me on the journey to the house of my master's relatives."

Gen. 24:49 Now if you will show kindness and **faithfulness** to my master, tell me; and if not, tell me, so I may know which way to turn."

Gen. 32:10 I am unworthy of all the kindness and **faithfulness** you have shown your servant. I had only my staff when I crossed this Jordan, but now I have become two groups.

Gen. 47:29 When the time drew near for Israel to die, he called for his son Joseph and said to him, "If I have found favor in your eyes, put your hand under my thigh and promise that you will show me kindness and **faithfulness**. Do not bury me in Egypt,

Ex. 34:6 And he passed in front of Moses, proclaiming, "The LORD, the LORD, the compassionate and gracious God, slow to anger, abounding in love and **faithfulness**,

Num. 12:7 But this is not true of my servant Moses;
he is **faithful** in all my house.

Dt. 7:9 Know therefore that the LORD your God is God; he is the **faithful** God, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commands.

Dt. 11:13 So if you **faithfully** obey the commands I am giving you today – to love the LORD your God and to serve him with all your heart and with all your soul –

Dt. 32:4 He is the Rock, his works are perfect,
and all his ways are just.
A **faithful** God who does no wrong,
upright and just is he.

Jsh. 2:14 "Our lives for your lives!" the men assured her. "If you don't tell what we are doing, we will treat you kindly and **faithfully** when the LORD gives us the land."

Jsh. 24:14 "Now fear the LORD and serve him with all **faithfulness**. Throw away the gods your forefathers worshiped beyond the River and in Egypt, and serve the LORD.

1Sam. 2:35 I will raise up for myself a **faithful** priest, who will do according to what is in my heart and mind. I will firmly establish his house, and he will minister before my anointed one always.

1Sam. 12:24 But be sure to fear the LORD and serve him **faithfully** with all your heart; consider what great things he has done for you.

1Sam. 26:23 The LORD rewards every man for his righteousness and **faithfulness**. The LORD delivered you into my hands today, but I would not lay a hand on the LORD's anointed.

2Sam. 2:6 May the LORD now show you kindness and **faithfulness**, and I too will show you the same favor because you have done this.

2Sam. 15:20 You came only yesterday. And today shall I make you wander about with us, when I do not know where I am going? Go back, and take your countrymen. May kindness and **faithfulness** be with you.”

2Sam. 20:19 We are the peaceful and **faithful** in Israel. You are trying to destroy a city that is a mother in Israel. Why do you want to swallow up the LORD’s inheritance?”

2Sam. 22:26 “To the **faithful** you show yourself **faithful**,
to the blameless you show yourself blameless,

1Ki. 2:4 and that the LORD may keep his promise to me: ‘If your descendants watch how they live, and if they walk **faithfully** before me with all their heart and soul, you will never fail to have a man on the throne of Israel.’

1Ki. 3:6 Solomon answered, “You have shown great kindness to your servant, my father David, because he was **faithful** to you and righteous and upright in heart. You have continued this great kindness to him and have given him a son to sit on his throne this very day.

2Ki. 20:3 “Remember, O LORD, how I have walked before you **faithfully** and with wholehearted devotion and have done what is good in your eyes.” And Hezekiah wept bitterly.

2Ki. 22:7 But they need not account for the money entrusted to them, because they are acting **faithfully**.”

2Chr. 19:9 He gave them these orders: “You must serve **faithfully** and wholeheartedly in the fear of the LORD.

2Chr. 31:12 Then they **faithfully** brought in the contributions, tithes and dedicated gifts. Conaniah, a Levite, was in charge of these things, and his brother Shimei was next in rank.

2Chr. 31:15 Eden, Miniamin, Jeshua, Shemaiah, Amariah and Shecaniah assisted him **faithfully** in the towns of the priests, distributing to their fellow priests according to their divisions, old and young alike.

2Chr. 31:18 They included all the little ones, the wives, and the sons and daughters of the whole community listed in these genealogical records. For they were **faithful** in consecrating themselves.

2Chr. 31:20 This is what Hezekiah did throughout Judah, doing what was good and right and **faithful** before the LORD his God.

2Chr. 32:1 After all that Hezekiah had so **faithfully** done, Sennacherib king of Assyria came and invaded Judah. He laid siege to the fortified cities, thinking to conquer them for himself.

2Chr. 34:12 The men did the work **faithfully**. Over them to direct them were Jahath and Obadiah, Levites descended from Merari, and Zechariah and Meshullam, descended from Kohath. The Levites – all who were skilled in playing musical instruments –

Neh. 9:8 You found his heart **faithful** to you, and you made a covenant with him to give to his descendants the land of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Jebusites and Girgashites. You have kept your promise because you are righteous.

- Ps. 18:25** To the **faithful** you show yourself **faithful**,
to the blameless you show yourself blameless,
- Ps. 25:10** All the ways of the LORD are loving and **faithful**
for those who keep the demands of his covenant.
- Ps. 30:9** “What gain is there in my destruction,
in my going down into the pit?
Will the dust praise you?
Will it proclaim your **faithfulness**?”
- Ps. 31:23** Love the LORD, all his saints!
The LORD preserves the **faithful**,
but the proud he pays back in full.
- Ps. 33:4** For the word of the LORD is right and true;
he is **faithful** in all he does.
- Ps. 36:5** Your love, O LORD, reaches to the heavens,
your **faithfulness** to the skies.
- Ps. 37:28** For the LORD loves the just
and will not forsake his **faithful** ones.
They will be protected forever,
but the offspring of the wicked will be cut off;

- Ps. 54:5** Let evil recoil on those who slander me;
in your **faithfulness** destroy them.
- Ps. 57:3** He sends from heaven and saves me, rebuking those who hotly pursue me; *Selah*
God sends his love and his **faithfulness**.
- Ps. 57:10** For great is your love, reaching to the heavens; your **faithfulness** reaches to the skies.
- Ps. 61:7** May he be enthroned in God’s presence forever;
appoint your love and **faithfulness** to protect him.

- Ps. 71:22** I will praise you with the harp
for your **faithfulness**, O my God;
I will sing praise to you with the lyre,
O Holy One of Israel.
- Ps. 78:8** They would not be like their forefathers –
a stubborn and rebellious generation,
whose hearts were not loyal to God,
whose spirits were not **faithful** to him.
- Ps. 78:37** their hearts were not loyal to him,
they were not **faithful** to his covenant.

you have done marvelous things,

- Is. 38:3** “Remember, O LORD, how I have walked before you **faithfully** and with wholehearted
devotion and have done what is good in your eyes.” And Hezekiah wept bitterly.
- Is. 38:18** For the grave cannot praise you,
death cannot sing your praise;
those who go down to the pit
cannot hope for your **faithfulness**.
- Is. 38:19** The living, the living – they praise you,
as I am doing today;
fathers tell their children
about your **faithfulness**.
- Is. 42:3** A bruised reed he will not break,
and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out.
In **faithfulness** he will bring forth justice;
- Is. 49:7** This is what the LORD says –
the Redeemer and Holy One of Israel –
to him who was despised and abhorred by the nation,
to the servant of rulers:
“Kings will see you and rise up,
princes will see and bow down,
because of the LORD, who is **faithful**,
the Holy One of Israel, who has chosen you.”
- Is. 55:3** Give ear and come to me;
hear me, that your soul may live.
I will make an everlasting covenant with you,
my **faithful** love promised to David.

- Is. 61:8** “For I, the LORD, love justice;
I hate robbery and iniquity.
In my **faithfulness** I will reward them
and make an everlasting covenant with them.
- Jer. 23:28** Let the prophet who has a dream tell his dream, but let the one who has my word speak it **faithfully**. For what has straw to do with grain?” declares the LORD.
- Jer. 42:5** Then they said to Jeremiah, “May the LORD be a true and **faithful** witness against us if we do not act in accordance with everything the LORD your God sends you to tell us.
- Lam. 3:23** They are new every morning;
great is your **faithfulness**.
- Ez. 18:9** He follows my decrees
and **faithfully** keeps my laws.
That man is righteous;
he will surely live, declares the Sovereign LORD.
- Ez. 43:11** and if they are ashamed of all they have done, make known to them the design of the temple – its arrangement, its exits and entrances – its whole design and all its regulations and laws. Write these down before them so that they may be **faithful** to its design and follow all its regulations.
- Ez. 44:15** “ ‘But the priests, who are Levites and descendants of Zadok and who **faithfully** carried out the duties of my sanctuary when the Israelites went astray from me, are to come near to minister before me; they are to stand before me to offer sacrifices of fat and blood, declares the Sovereign LORD.

because the LORD has a charge to bring
against you who live in the land:

But you have neglected the more important matters of the law – justice, mercy and **faithfulness**. You should have practiced the latter, without neglecting the former.
- Mt. 24:45** “Who then is the **faithful** and wise servant, whom the master has put in charge of the servants in his household to give them their food at the proper time?
- Mt. 25:21** “His master replied, ‘Well done, good and **faithful** servant! You have been **faithful** with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master’s happiness!’
- Mt. 25:23** “His master replied, ‘Well done, good and **faithful** servant! You have been **faithful** with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master’s happiness!’
- Lk. 12:42** The Lord answered, “Who then is the **faithful** and wise manager, whom the master puts in charge of his servants to give them their food allowance at the proper time?
- Rom. 3:3** What if some did not have faith? Will their lack of faith nullify God’s **faithfulness**?
- Rom. 12:12** Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, **faithful** in prayer.
- 1Cor. 1:9** God, who has called you into fellowship with his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, is **faithful**.
- 1Cor. 4:2** Now it is required that those who have been given a trust must prove **faithful**.
- 1Cor. 4:17** For this reason I am sending to you Timothy, my son whom I love, who is **faithful** in the Lord. He will remind you of my way of life in Christ Jesus, which agrees with what I teach everywhere in every church.
- 1Cor. 10:13** No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is **faithful**; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.
- 2Cor. 1:18** But as surely as God is **faithful**, our message to you is not “Yes” and “No.”
- Gal. 5:22** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, **faithfulness**,
- Eph. 1:1** Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God,
To the saints in Ephesus, the **faithful** in Christ Jesus:
- Eph. 6:21** Tychicus, the dear brother and **faithful** servant in the Lord, will tell you everything, so that you also may know how I am and what I am doing.
- Col. 1:2** To the holy and **faithful** brothers in Christ at Colosse:
Grace and peace to you from God our Father.
- Col. 1:7** You learned it from Epaphras, our dear fellow servant, who is a **faithful** minister of Christ on our behalf,
- Col. 4:7** Tychicus will tell you all the news about me. He is a dear brother, a **faithful** minister and fellow servant in the Lord.

- Col. 4:9** He is coming with Onesimus, our **faithful** and dear brother, who is one of you. They will tell you everything that is happening here.
- 1Th. 5:24** The one who calls you is **faithful** and he will do it.
- 2Th. 3:3** But the Lord is **faithful**, and he will strengthen and protect you from the evil one.
- 1Tim. 1:12** I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who has given me strength, that he considered me **faithful**, appointing me to his service.
- 1Tim. 5:9** No widow may be put on the list of widows unless she is over sixty, has been **faithful** to her husband,
- 2Tim. 2:13** if we are faithless,
he will remain **faithful**,
for he cannot disown himself.
- Heb. 2:17** For this reason he had to be made like his brothers in every way, in order that he might become a merciful and **faithful** high priest in service to God, and that he might make atonement for the sins of the people.
- Heb. 3:2** He was **faithful** to the one who appointed him, just as Moses was **faithful** in all God's house.
- Heb. 3:5** Moses was **faithful** as a servant in all God's house, testifying to what would be said in the future. ⁶ But Christ is **faithful** as a son over God's house. And we are his house, if we hold on to our courage and the hope of which we boast.
- Heb. 8:9** It will not be like the covenant
I made with their forefathers
when I took them by the hand
to lead them out of Egypt,
because they did not remain **faithful** to my covenant,
and I turned away from them, declares the Lord.
- Heb. 10:23** Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is **faithful**.
- Heb. 11:11** By faith Abraham, even though he was past age – and Sarah herself was barren – was enabled to become a father because he considered him **faithful** who had made the promise.
- 1Pt. 4:10** Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, **faithfully** administering God's grace in its various forms.
- 1Pt. 4:19** So then, those who suffer according to God's will should commit themselves to their **faithful** Creator and continue to do good.
- 1Pt. 5:12** With the help of Silas, whom I regard as a **faithful** brother, I have written to you briefly, encouraging you and testifying that this is the true grace of God. Stand fast in it.
- 1Jn. 1:9** If we confess our sins, he is **faithful** and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

- 3Jn. 3** It gave me great joy to have some brothers come and tell about your **faithfulness** to the truth and how you continue to walk in the truth.
- 3Jn. 5** Dear friend, you are **faithful** in what you are doing for the brothers, even though they are strangers to you.
- Rev. 1:5** and from Jesus Christ, who is the **faithful** witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth.
To him who loves us and has freed us from our sins by his blood,
- Rev. 2:10** Do not be afraid of what you are about to suffer. I tell you, the devil will put some of you in prison to test you, and you will suffer persecution for ten days. Be **faithful**, even to the point of death, and I will give you the crown of life.
- Rev. 2:13** I know where you live – where Satan has his throne. Yet you remain true to my name. You did not renounce your faith in me, even in the days of Antipas, my **faithful** witness, who was put to death in your city – where Satan lives.
- Rev. 3:14** “To the angel of the church in Laodicea write:
These are the words of the Amen, the **faithful** and true witness, the ruler of God’s creation.
- Rev. 13:10** If anyone is to go into captivity,
into captivity he will go.
If anyone is to be killed with the sword,
with the sword he will be killed.
This calls for patient endurance and **faithfulness** on the part of the saints.
- Rev. 14:12** This calls for patient endurance on the part of the saints who obey God’s commandments and remain **faithful** to Jesus.
- Rev. 17:14** They will make war against the Lamb, but the Lamb will overcome them because he is Lord of lords and King of kings – and with him will be his called, chosen and **faithful** followers.”
- Rev. 19:11** I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called **Faithful** and True. With justice he judges and makes war.
