- Dt. 28:54** Even the most **gentle** and sensitive man among you will have no compassion on his own brother or the wife he loves or his surviving children,
- Dt. 28:56** The most **gentle** and sensitive woman among you – so sensitive and **gentle** that she would not venture to touch the ground with the sole of her foot – will begrudge the husband she loves and her own son or daughter
- 2Sam. 18:5** The king commanded Joab, Abishai and Ittai, “Be **gentle** with the young man Absalom for my sake.” And all the troops heard the king giving orders concerning Absalom to each of the commanders.
- 1Ki. 19:12** After the earthquake came a fire, but the LORD was not in the fire. And after the fire came a **gentle** whisper.
