- Ex. 33:19** And the LORD said, “I will cause all my **goodness** to pass in front of you, and I will proclaim my name, the LORD, in your presence. I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.
- 2Chr. 6:41** “Now arise, O LORD God, and come to your resting place, you and the ark of your might.  
May your priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation,  
may your saints rejoice in your **goodness**.
- Neh. 9:25** They captured fortified cities and fertile land; they took possession of houses filled with all kinds of good things, wells already dug, vineyards, olive groves and fruit trees in abundance. They ate to the full and were well-nourished; they reveled in your great **goodness**.
- Neh. 9:35** Even while they were in their kingdom, enjoying your great **goodness** to them in the spacious and fertile land you gave them, they did not serve you or turn from their evil ways.
