

kind / kindest / kindhearted / kindly / kindness / kindnesses

NOTE: Only the verses containing the word “kind” when it has the meaning “nice” were used. The references of the word “kind” when it means “variety” were omitted.

- Gen. 19:19** Your servant has found favor in your eyes, and you have shown great **kindness** to me in sparing my life. But I can't flee to the mountains; this disaster will overtake me, and I'll die.
- Gen. 21:23** Now swear to me here before God that you will not deal falsely with me or my children or my descendants. Show to me and the country where you are living as an alien the same **kindness** I have shown to you.”
- Gen. 24:12** Then he prayed, “O LORD, God of my master Abraham, give me success today, and show **kindness** to my master Abraham.
- Gen. 24:14** May it be that when I say to a girl, ‘Please let down your jar that I may have a drink,’ and she says, ‘Drink, and I'll water your camels too’ – let her be the one you have chosen for your servant Isaac. By this I will know that you have shown **kindness** to my master.”
- Gen. 24:27** saying, “Praise be to the LORD, the God of my master Abraham, who has not abandoned his **kindness** and faithfulness to my master. As for me, the LORD has led me on the journey to the house of my master's relatives.”
- Gen. 24:49** Now if you will show **kindness** and faithfulness to my master, tell me; and if not, tell me, so I may know which way to turn.”
- Gen. 32:10** I am unworthy of all the **kindness** and faithfulness you have shown your servant. I had only my staff when I crossed this Jordan, but now I have become two groups.
- Gen. 37:4** When his brothers saw that their father loved him more than any of them, they hated him and could not speak a **kind** word to him.
- Gen. 39:21** the LORD was with him; he showed him **kindness** and granted him favor in the eyes of the prison warden.
- Gen. 40:14** But when all goes well with you, remember me and show me **kindness**; mention me to Pharaoh and get me out of this prison.
- Gen. 47:29** When the time drew near for Israel to die, he called for his son Joseph and said to him, “If I have found favor in your eyes, put your hand under my thigh and promise that you will show me **kindness** and faithfulness. Do not bury me in Egypt,
- Gen. 50:21** So then, don't be afraid. I will provide for you and your children.” And he reassured them and spoke **kindly** to them.
- Ex. 1:20** So God was **kind** to the midwives and the people increased and became even more numerous.
- Josh. 2:12** Now then, please swear to me by the LORD that you will show **kindness** to my family, because I have shown **kindness** to you. Give me a sure sign

Josh. 2:14 “Our lives for your lives!” the men assured her. “If you don’t tell what we are doing, we will treat you **kindly** and faithfully when the LORD gives us the land.”

Judg. 8:35 They also failed to show **kindness** to the family of Jerub-Baal (that is, Gideon) for all the good things he had done for them.

Judg. 21:22 When their fathers or brothers complain to us, we will say to them, ‘Do us a **kindness** by helping them, because we did not get wives for them during the war, and you are innocent, since you did not give your daughters to them.’”

Ruth 1:8 Then Naomi said to her two daughters-in-law, “Go back, each of you, to your mother’s home. May the LORD show **kindness** to you, as you have shown to your dead and to me.

Ruth 2:13 “May I continue to find favor in your eyes, my lord,” she said. “You have given me comfort and have spoken **kindly** to your servant – though I do not have the standing of one of your servant girls.”

Ruth 2:20 “The LORD bless him!” Naomi said to her daughter-in-law. “He has not stopped showing his **kindness** to the living and the dead.” She added, “That man is our close relative; he is one of our kinsman-redeemers.”

Ruth 3:10 “The LORD bless you, my daughter,” he replied. “This **kindness** is greater than that which you showed earlier: You have not run after the younger men, whether rich or poor.

1Sam. 15:6 Then he said to the Kenites, “Go away, leave the Amalekites so that I do not destroy you along with them; for you showed **kindness** to all the Israelites when they came up out of Egypt.” So the Kenites moved away from the Amalekites.

1Sam. 20:8 As for you, show **kindness** to your servant, for you have brought him into a covenant with you before the LORD. If I am guilty, then kill me yourself! Why hand me over to your father?”

1Sam. 20:14 But show me unflinching **kindness** like that of the LORD as long as I live, so that I may not be killed, ¹⁵ and do not ever cut off your **kindness** from my family – not even when the LORD has cut off every one of David’s enemies from the face of the earth.”

2Sam. 2:5 he sent messengers to the men of Jabesh Gilead to say to them, “The LORD bless you for showing this **kindness** to Saul your master by burying him. ⁶ May the LORD now show you **kindness** and faithfulness, and I too will show you the same favor because you have done this.

2Sam. 9:1 David asked, “Is there anyone still left of the house of Saul to whom I can show **kindness** for Jonathan’s sake?”

2Sam. 9:3 The king asked, “Is there no one still left of the house of Saul to whom I can show God’s **kindness**?”

Ziba answered the king, “There is still a son of Jonathan; he is crippled in both feet.”

2Sam. 9:7 “Don’t be afraid,” David said to him, “for I will surely show you **kindness** for the sake of your father Jonathan. I will restore to you all the land that belonged to your grandfather Saul, and you will always eat at my table.”

2Sam. 10:2 David thought, “I will show **kindness** to Hanun son of Nahash, just as his father showed **kindness** to me.” So David sent a delegation to express his sympathy to Hanun concerning his father.

When David’s men came to the land of the Ammonites,

2Sam. 15:20 You came only yesterday. And today shall I make you wander about with us, when I do not know where I am going? Go back, and take your countrymen. May **kindness** and faithfulness be with you.”

2Sam. 22:51 He gives his king great victories;
he shows unfailing **kindness** to his anointed,
to David and his descendants forever.”

1Kings 2:7 “But show **kindness** to the sons of Barzillai of Gilead and let them be among those who eat at your table. They stood by me when I fled from your brother Absalom.

1Kings 3:6 Solomon answered, “You have shown great **kindness** to your servant, my father David, because he was faithful to you and righteous and upright in heart. You have continued this great **kindness** to him and have given him a son to sit on his throne this very day.

2Kings 25:28 He spoke **kindly** to him and gave him a seat of honor higher than those of the other kings who were with him in Babylon.

1Chr. 19:2 David thought, “I will show **kindness** to Hanun son of Nahash, because his father showed **kindness** to me.” So David sent a delegation to express his sympathy to Hanun concerning his father.

When David’s men came to Hanun in the land of the Ammonites to express sympathy to him,

2Chr. 1:8 Solomon answered God, “You have shown great **kindness** to David my father and have made me king in his place.

2Chr. 10:7 They replied, “If you will be **kind** to these people and please them and give them a favorable answer, they will always be your servants.”

2Chr. 24:22 King Joash did not remember the **kindness** Zechariah’s father Jehoiada had shown him but killed his son, who said as he lay dying, “May the LORD see this and call you to account.”

2Chr. 32:25 But Hezekiah’s heart was proud and he did not respond to the **kindness** shown him; therefore the LORD’s wrath was on him and on Judah and Jerusalem.

Ezra 9:9 Though we are slaves, our God has not deserted us in our bondage. He has shown us **kindness** in the sight of the kings of Persia: He has granted us new life to rebuild the house of our God and repair its ruins, and he has given us a wall of protection in Judah and Jerusalem.

Job 6:28 “But now be so **kind** as to look at me.
Would I lie to your face?

Job 10:12 You gave me life and showed me **kindness**,
and in your providence watched over my spirit.

- Job 24:21** They prey on the barren and childless woman,
and to the widow show no **kindness**.
- Psa. 18:50** He gives his king great victories;
he shows unfailing **kindness** to his anointed,
to David and his descendants forever.
- Psa. 106:7** When our fathers were in Egypt,
they gave no thought to your miracles;
they did not remember your many **kindnesses**,
and they rebelled by the sea, the Red Sea.
- Psa. 109:12** May no one extend **kindness** to him
or take pity on his fatherless children.
- Psa. 109:16** For he never thought of doing a **kindness**,
but hounded to death the poor
and the needy and the brokenhearted.
- Psa. 141:5** Let a righteous man strike me – it is a **kindness**;
let him rebuke me – it is oil on my head.
My head will not refuse it.
Yet my prayer is ever against the deeds of evildoers;
- Prov. 11:16** A **kindhearted** woman gains respect,
but ruthless men gain only wealth.
- Prov. 11:17** A **kind** man benefits himself,
but a cruel man brings trouble on himself.
- Prov. 12:10** A righteous man cares for the needs of his animal,
but the **kindest** acts of the wicked are cruel.
- Prov. 12:25** An anxious heart weighs a man down,
but a **kind** word cheers him up.
- Prov. 14:21** He who despises his neighbor sins,
but blessed is he who is **kind** to the needy.
- Prov. 14:31** He who oppresses the poor shows contempt for their Maker,
but whoever is **kind** to the needy honors God.
- Prov. 19:17** He who is **kind** to the poor lends to the LORD,
and he will reward him for what he has done.
- Prov. 28:8** He who increases his wealth by exorbitant interest
amasses it for another, who will be **kind** to the poor.

- Is. 54:8** In a surge of anger
I hid my face from you for a moment,
but with everlasting **kindness**
I will have compassion on you,”
says the LORD your Redeemer.
- Is. 63:7** I will tell of the **kindnesses** of the LORD,
the deeds for which he is to be praised,
according to all the LORD has done for us –
yes, the many good things he has done
for the house of Israel,
according to his compassion and many **kindnesses**.
- Jer. 9:24** but let him who boasts boast about this:
that he understands and knows me,
that I am the LORD, who exercises **kindness**,
justice and righteousness on earth,
for in these I delight,” declares the LORD.
- Jer. 52:32** He spoke **kindly** to him and gave him a seat of honor higher than those of the other kings
who were with him in Babylon.
- Dan. 4:27** Therefore, O king, be pleased to accept my advice: Renounce your sins by doing what is
right, and your wickedness by being **kind** to the oppressed. It may be that then your prosperity
will continue.”
- Hos. 11:4** I led them with cords of human **kindness**,
with ties of love;
I lifted the yoke from their neck
and bent down to feed them.
- Zech. 1:13** So the LORD spoke **kind** and comforting words to the angel who talked with me.
- Luke 6:35** **But love your enemies, do good to them, and lend to them without expecting to get
anything back. Then your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, because
he is kind to the ungrateful and wicked.**
- Acts 4:9** If we are being called to account today for an act of **kindness** shown to a cripple and are
asked how he was healed,
- Acts 14:17** Yet he has not left himself without testimony: He has shown **kindness** by giving you rain
from heaven and crops in their seasons; he provides you with plenty of food and fills your hearts
with joy.”
- Acts 24:4** But in order not to weary you further, I would request that you be **kind** enough to hear us
briefly.
- Acts 27:3** The next day we landed at Sidon; and Julius, in **kindness** to Paul, allowed him to go to his
friends so they might provide for his needs.
- Acts 28:2** The islanders showed us unusual **kindness**. They built a fire and welcomed us all
because it was raining and cold.

- Rom. 2:4** Or do you show contempt for the riches of his **kindness**, tolerance and patience, not realizing that God's **kindness** leads you toward repentance?
- Rom. 11:22** Consider therefore the **kindness** and sternness of God: sternness to those who fell, but **kindness** to you, provided that you continue in his **kindness**. Otherwise, you also will be cut off.
- 1Cor. 4:13** when we are slandered, we answer **kindly**. Up to this moment we have become the scum of the earth, the refuse of the world.
- 1Cor. 13:4** Love is patient, love is **kind**. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud.
- 2Cor. 6:6** in purity, understanding, patience and **kindness**; in the Holy Spirit and in sincere love;
- Gal. 5:22** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, **kindness**, goodness, faithfulness,
- Eph. 2:7** in order that in the coming ages he might show the incomparable riches of his grace, expressed in his **kindness** to us in Christ Jesus.
- Eph. 4:32** Be **kind** and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.
- Col. 3:12** Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, **kindness**, humility, gentleness and patience.
- 1Th. 5:15** Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always try to be **kind** to each other and to everyone else.
- 2Tim. 2:24** And the Lord's servant must not quarrel; instead, he must be **kind** to everyone, able to teach, not resentful.
- Titus 2:5** to be self-controlled and pure, to be busy at home, to be **kind**, and to be subject to their husbands, so that no one will malign the word of God.
- Titus 3:4** But when the **kindness** and love of God our Savior appeared,
- 2Pet. 1:7** and to godliness, brotherly **kindness**; and to brotherly **kindness**, love.
